Hello,

Thank you for your interest in finding out some information about Greenfield Baptist Church in Llanelli. Whether you live locally, and have never been before, or visiting the area on holiday, please use this download to assist with making your travel arrangements.

Finding **GREENFIELD** for the first time isn't as hard and as daunting as you might think! Situated in the centre of Llanelli, it is readily accessible to routes for West and East Wales via the M4 motorway, but to help you to find us, here are some directions from our website:

DIRECTIONS FROM THE M4 MOTORWAY:

Exit the M4 at Junction 48, signposted to Llanelli. Follow the main road through three roundabouts. At the fourth roundabout located next to McDonalds and Tesco's, take the fourth exit off the roundabout signposted to Llanelli.

Continue in to the town centre, via the roundabout at Kwik Save, by taking the exit in to Stepney Place. Continue on this road through a series of pelican crossings, passed Asda, and leading in to Murray Street.

Upon reaching the main traffic light junction next to Llanelli Cinema, you will find GREENFIELD BAPTIST CHURCH on the left-hand corner.

DIRECTIONS FROM LLANELLI RAILWAY STATION:

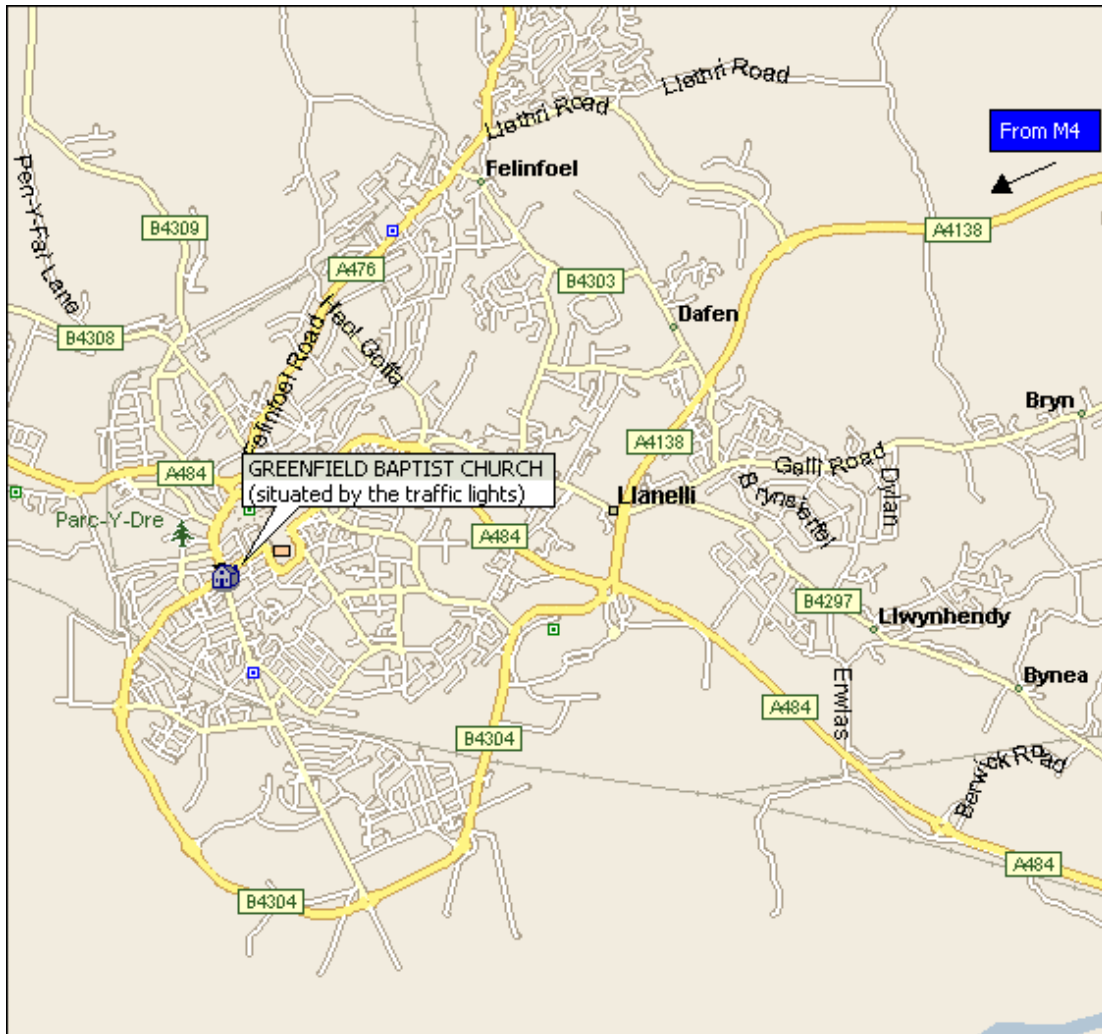
From the Railway station exit, walk **RIGHT** from the main exit to the main road called **Station Road**. Turn **left**, as walking up Station Road will lead to the traffic light junction where Greenfield is situated. This walk will take 10 – 15 minutes. Alternatively, a taxi rank is situated outside the Station.

MAPS:

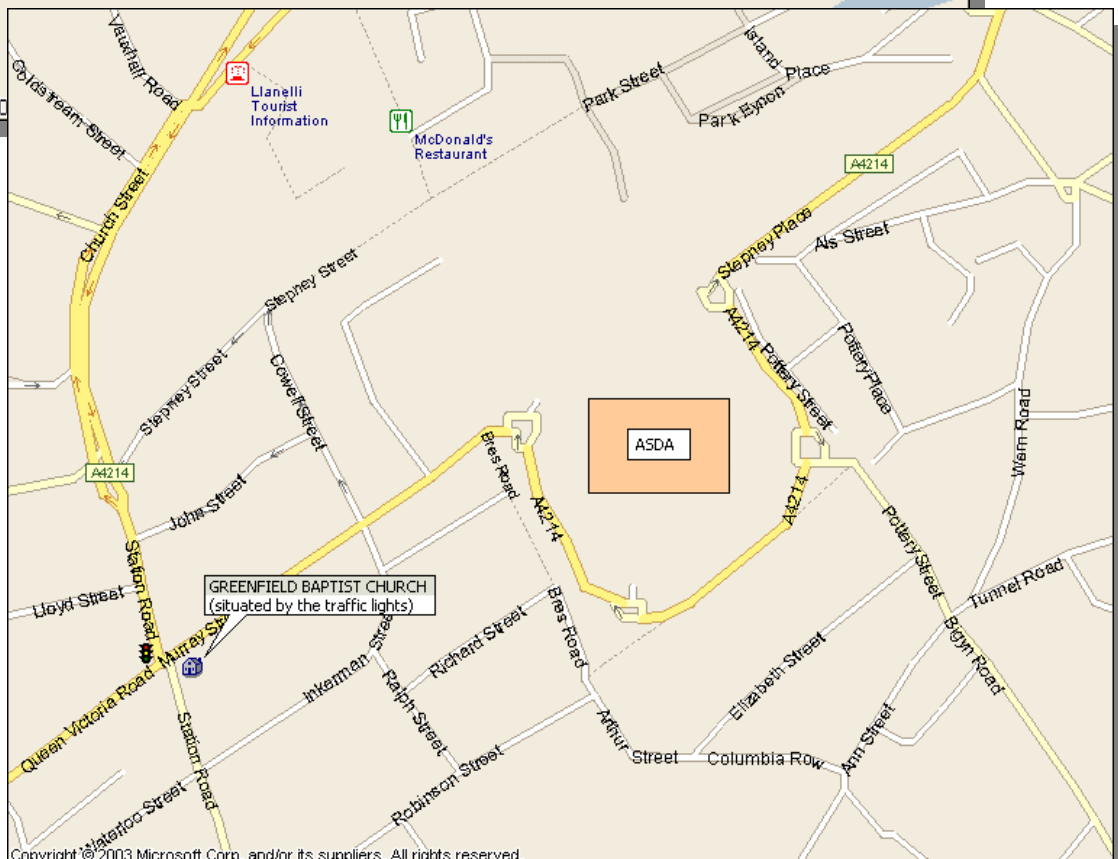
To help with your journey, we have attached a map of the route in from Junction 48 of the M4 and a basic street plan of the area around Greenfield for your use.
